Connecting Activity: By Tina Skuce

 - o It was noted that it was mentioned a number of times by mentors they were not sure of how often to meet with the PT(s) and for how long.

CCCOE Teacher Induction Program Site Administrator Information/Updates: By Charise Calone

- Site Administrator Commitment Letters
 - o Still collecting a few outstanding commitment letters; noted on handout in packet.

- Site Administrator Communication
 - Website has a tab for Site Administrators
 - Some confusion regarding the date on SA Breakfast for March 2016 may need to change this on the website
 - o Charise will be sending out a newsletter to the Site Administrators
 - Request was made to send the newsletter out to the Leadership Team as well.
- Site Administrator Consultation: documentation on ILP this year
 - o New this year, seemed to go well and accepted by the Site Administrators.
 - o Several individuals shared how this can be tied into the Part A evaluation
 - o Lengthy discussion on the possibility of using Google Docs for the Induction Program.
 - Concern voiced on if all districts use Google docs?
 - Some districts only use Google docs and this does not transfer over well in to or from a Word document; especially if tables are use in the Word doc.
- End of Year Survey: Site Administrator Survey Results Expert Partnerships
 - Group divided into two groups to review different question responses from the Site Administrators survey. Each group was asked to highlight strengths and growth areas, and then report out to the group.
 - Group A (Questions #3-5 and #9)
 - <u>Strengths</u>: Lots of positive response; CCCOE was very responsive to what was asked for- it is being done this year; appreciated the newsletter
 - <u>Growth Areas</u>: Do not participate, did not know who their PTs and mentors were, budget questions
 - Questions to Ponder: Did the triads help? How? Is the breakfast meeting the needs?

- Group B (Questions #6-8 and #9)
 - Strengths: Lots of positive comments
 - Growth Areas: Do the Site Administrators really understand the questions being asked in the survey? Some conflicting answers. Do the Site Administrators understand the ILP?
 - Questions to Ponder: 65% did not report they decreased the duties and preps when PTs reported a struggle; the response that answered don't know who to ask if they have questions

- New Mentor Training Year 1 and Year 2 are all done, even with the power outages. Thank you for your patience with the power outages.
- Mentor Seminar Training Updates
 - o In September the mentors were asked to offer suggestions on what they would like to discuss in the sessions
- Mentor Seminar Cohorts Scheduled
 - Cohort 7 has been cancelled due to low enrollment, those enrolled were moved to a different cohort.
 - o An additional cohort date will be added in January for two districts that have a conflict with exam week. Charise is working on the date with these districts.
 - o A request was made to have the Advanced Mentor Seminars like the past year.
