Strategic Elements

Educational research has determined that there are specific elements of the California Standards for the Teaching Profession (CSTP) that are essential as strategic areas of focus to impact student achievement and teacher growth. *These are suggested elements; you may choose any element from the CSTP chart on the other side of this document as your focus areas.

CSTP 1 Engaging and Supporting All Students in Learning
